Located upstream of Boston Street in Middleton, the South Middleton Dam is the farthest upstream of three dams on the main Ipswich River. The aging structure no longer serves its original function, but still requires regular inspection and maintenance to keep it safe. The dam also blocks access to 56 miles of streams for fish migration. Working with a broad coalition of partners, the dam owner, Bostik Inc., plans to remove the dam in 2016 and restore natural river conditions through this stretch of the Ipswich.
