

Below are the **existing categories** of outdoor watering restrictions for Middleton which are in place May – September each year to conserve water in the Ipswich Watershed Basin. **There is no change to these measures if you vote YES on Warrant Article 30.**

## OUTDOOR WATER RESTRICTIONS

<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>LEVEL 1</b>	Normal Winter Conditions - (Oct.1 to April 30) <b>NO RESTRICTIONS</b>
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>LEVEL 2</b>	Seasonal Restrictions - (May 1 to Sept. 30) Outdoor lawn & garden watering allowed between the hours of 7:00PM and 8:00AM ONLY
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>LEVEL 3</b> Drought Condition	Outdoor lawn & garden watering allowed 3 days a week ONLY (Tues., Thurs., and Sat.)  Outdoor lawn & garden watering allowed between the hours of 7:00PM and 8:00AM ONLY
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>LEVEL 4</b> Drought Condition	Outdoor lawn & garden watering allowed 2 days a week ONLY (Tues. and Sat.)  Outdoor lawn & garden watering allowed between the hours of 7:00PM and 10:00PM ONLY
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>LEVEL 5</b> Drought Condition	Outdoor lawn & garden watering by hand-held hoses and cans ONLY  Hand-held lawn & garden watering ONLY from 7:00PM to 8:00AM  NO filling swimming pools NO washing of cars
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>LEVEL 6</b> Drought Condition	<b>NO OUTDOOR WATER USE ALLOWED</b>
